Wish to raise the following very serious concerns,

Firstly that our full cooperation and comprehensive submissions to the Charity Commission do not appear to have been read in light of your last email.

Secondly that given this Charity has and continues to challenge the Conservative Government in same way that we would challenge a Labour Government had the unprecedented slaughter of elderly people in care homes taken place on their watch. We believe that Charities should be challenging Governments on such issues as these and that is exactly why we do not accept Government or Care Industry money. I attach Our Covid 9th report to Boris Johnson as a typical example of our work.

Whilst we are used to writing to Government we normally receive an acknowledgment within two weeks and a response within six weeks, we have never waited 5 months for a response or even an acknowledgement to a letter before now which indicates our challenges are feared..

It has been drawn to our my attention by a very reliable source that the current head of the Charity Commission is a former Conservative Minister with various connections and that this appointment was objected to at the time on those grounds.

It has also been pointed out to us that the malicious complaints made about this Charity have been made by members of or connected to the Conservative party and who are also donors to the Conservative party.

As this Charity has never had a single complaint made against it until now, I am sure you will understand our concerns that complaints about the content on our charity website and our speaking to the press could well be viewed very differently in light of these facts, political censorship must be viewed by us as a real possibility.

The complainant is also clearly malicious due to the fact we exposed their misconduct, misconduct that is so serious, they must indeed be protected to

have retained their parliamentary public office to date. For all of these reasons we have lost all trust in the Charity Commission. We have also been contacted by Charity law experts who are appalled at the way this Charity is being treated by the Commission and have urged us to seek proper scrutiny of how the investigation has been handled and legal representation. We therefore are seeking permission to crowd fund for legal representation as a matter of urgency and in the interests of justice.
