What a CQC Good Rating Really Means

The long and sorry tale of Parkview care home has been well documented on our website since multiple and credible concerns from a number of sources were brought to our attention. The acting manager in particular, who amid all these concerns was considered to be a fit and proper person by the CQC,

In spite an on-going NMC inquiry, into multiple allegations of poor care and fatal neglect, Committing perjury in a coroner's court, last but not least claiming NHS funds for nursing care in a residential care home.

Despite CQCs written assurances to me that "*Parkview has not provided nursing care since 2014*" my Freedom of Information Request to the local CCG proved this was not the case at all but that the home was currently claiming NHS funding and had also done so in the past.

Indeed, Parkview only changed its website recently after constant pressure from this charity, from nursing to residential care.

The latest CQC report of course mentions none of this, indeed the CQC have not even responded to my last letter pointing out to them that their assurances were of little value given the facts I had obtained and exposed.

The latest report rates the home good on scant evidence, disregarding all the known facts and given that the last CQC report found the home to have breached its registration criteria in admitting more people than it was registered to care for, no mention of this is made in the latest CQC report.

Given the volume of evidence available to CQC I can only conclude that a CQC rating is good for nothing and cannot be relied upon by the public.
