And much more during Covid 19 and I can hear no shouts of protest from Westminster.

It goes much deeper than the metal fatigued, Covid infected, rusty ring that was put around care homes. What has happened during Covid has simply opened up

the festering rot at the heart of our political systems, a rot that long ago gave up any pretence of democracy, decency or anything other than jobs for the boys and girls who tow the line, justify the wrong, excuse the abuse and coverup the incompetent in order to earn a wage or further personal ambitions and compromised agendas.

I am not political, have no allegiance to any party. I am still the care worker trying to do the right thing, trying to stop the needless suffering and cruel abuse of defenceless people. The act of whistleblowing has brought me on a journey that has included,

Rewriting Whistleblowing Law by defining the essence of public interest,

Taking on regulators such as the CQC and exposing their shocking failings and blatant dishonesty.

Fighting to have the principles of The Rule of Law upheld.

Challenging Governments and fighting for the right to life to be upheld in the UK.

This charity has documented evidence that we have saved thousands of lives because of the support we have given.

Seeing the bigger picture and questioning everything. Our work exposing the shocking exploitation of Whistleblowers by WBUK has torn away the remnants of trust in Parliament.

Uk Parliament has allowed whistleblower law to be sold to the highest bidder, the APPG lobbying system; loopholes which are open to abuse, the Nolen principles are a joke.

We are targeted with malicious allegations by WBUK for exposing their gross misconduct and evidenced lies, for standing up for exploited Whistleblowers and those they were trying to protect.

The gulf between ordinary decent people and those who meant to represent us has turned into an unbreachable chasm.
